Cost: \$165. For families with multiple children we are able to offer a 50% discount. Youth #1 would be \$185 and youth #2 would be \$85.

Start and End time: Starts 7pm-8pm.

Leaving DUMC Friday Sept 27th @4:30pm(dinner will be provided), arriving back around 2:30pm on Sunday Sept 29th.

How we are getting there: A 15 passenger van and another vehicle.

Accommodations: We are staying in cabins that hold 12-18 people(Dumc girls will be in one cabin and Dumc boys with be in another. If we don't fill the cabin they may put us with another group.)

Adult Volunteers: All volunteers will be background checked, the goal is to bring at least 2 male and 2 female adults. If you are interested in volunteering for the retreat please email me! We will maintain at least a 1:5 ratio per gender.

Phones: Whether or not your student brings their phone is for you to decide in your family what is best. Phones will be allowed to come. However, I will be encouraging them to be present with those around them and encouraging them to keep their use to a minimum. If phones become a distraction, they will be told phones need to stay in the cabins. Phones will be collected during worship time, lesson, and small groups.

Spending Money: T-shirts will be available for \$12, special edition shirts are \$18 and hoodies are \$30. There will also be snacks for sale during free time!

Medicine: A nurse is onsite all weekend. A medical form for the camp will need to be filled out before going.(Forms from the camp will be given to me after I register our spots.) Parents will be given the option if they want the medicine to stay with the youth or if you would like me to hold on to it.
